We had our third Strategic Planning Steering Committee meeting Tuesday, January 14th and we are off to a strong start this Winter Quarter. Below I've provided a summary of the meeting, but first a few notes:

UCR 2020 Progress Report Feedback

In 2010, UC Riverside created "UCR 2020", a strategic plan for the following decade. As that decade nears an end, we have created a progress report to summarize related data and evidence. Working groups have begun their community engagement and information gathering processes via campus meetings, surveys, interviews, and hosting presentations by various stakeholder groups. Through presentation and discussion in the Steering Committee meeting, working groups are discovering intersections of work and cross-cutting themes and ideas. Inter-group discussions are continuing outside of the Steering Committee meetings.
- **Next Steps:** Members are encouraged to continue sharing ideas and resources between groups, developing deeper themes and ideas. Working groups will continue meeting and gathering information. Members will work with the Steering Committee/AKA Strategy to coordinate engagement efforts across campus and in the community. These may include opportunities to participate in campus-wide forums later in the Winter Quarter.
